

Wine tasting outing New Lodge Vineyard 11 July 2018

New Lodge Vineyard is a small boutique vineyard situated on the outskirts of Earls Barton, set on a picturesque, southwest facing gentle slope overlooking the Nene Valley. Its location is very near to one of the oldest recorded vineyards of Roman times.

The vineyard was established in 2000 on horse paddocks, providing a lush fertile land of crumbly well drained loam over ironstone, and initially planted with Bacchus, Phoenix and Seyval grape varieties, then expanded in 2010 to include Solaris, Regent and Pinot Noir. These popular red and white grape varieties were chosen particularly for their suitability to withstand our English microclimate.
